## How to read this

---

This is not a fortune. I am not going to tell you what is going to happen to you. I am going to tell you how you are built. Your chart is a tool, a map of the energy you were born under, and this reading is me walking you through yours.

Read it in layers, the way your chart was built. We start with the core of who you are, then how you operate day to day, then where your soul is trying to grow, then where all of it actually shows up in your life. By the end you will see the single thread that ties the whole thing together.

Take your time with it. One piece at a time. Come back to it when a season of your life changes, because you will read it differently every time.

## Your Big Three: the spine of who you are

---

Three placements carry the weight of your whole chart. Your Sun, your Moon, and your Rising. Understand these and you already know the core of yourself, before we touch anything else.

☉ **Your Sun in Sagittarius.** Your Sun is the core of you, the self you are here to grow into across your whole life. Yours sits in Sagittarius, the seeker. Sagittarius is fire, so you run on inspiration and instinct, and it is mutable, so you keep reaching for the next horizon. At your center you are built to chase meaning. Not facts for their own sake, but the truth behind the thing, the why. And for you, that search is built to be lived out in the open, through your work and the mark you leave on the world, not kept quietly to yourself. Here is what that actually looks like in your life. You are the one who cannot stay in a job, a city, or a relationship that feels empty, even a comfortable one, because a life without meaning reads to you like a cage. You are the person who turns a quick dinner into a two-hour conversation about what it all means and where it is all going. When you travel, learn something new, or take a leap toward a bigger vision, you come alive. When life shrinks down to routine with no purpose attached to it, you feel it faster and heavier than the people around you. So the work of your Sun is simple to say and hard to live. Keep something meaningful in front of you, always, and let it pull you forward.

☽ **Your Moon in Taurus.** If your Sun is who you are in the light, your Moon is who you are underneath, in private, when no one is watching. It is your emotions, your instincts, and most of all your needs, the things that have to be there for you to feel safe. Yours is in Taurus, and Taurus needs solid ground, and for you that ground is woven into the ordinary fabric of your daily life: your routines, your words, the immediate world right around you. Here is how that shows up. When life gets chaotic or stressful, you do not want to talk it out right away. You reach for the familiar: your own bed, a real meal, your routine, your own space, something physical you can actually feel. And once you have settled, the way back to yourself is putting what you feel into plain words with the people closest to you. That is not you being boring, that is how you steady yourself. You take your time trusting people, but once someone is truly in, you are loyal and you stay. And you will not be rushed into a big emotional decision. Push you to choose before you are ready and you will plant your feet and refuse to move. This is your ballast. While your Sagittarius Sun is reaching for the horizon, your Taurus Moon is what keeps you from blowing away. Build a life with real ground under it and you can chase almost anything from there.

♈ **Your Aquarius Rising.** Your Rising is the energy you lead with out the door, the version of you people meet before they know the rest. Yours is Aquarius, the visionary, so you come across as your own person. Here is what others actually pick up. The first read on you is that you are a little different, that you march to your own beat and are not just running the script everyone else is running. In a group, you are the one who questions the thing everybody has already agreed on, the one who says wait, what if we looked at this another way. You walk into a new situation hunting for the angle nobody else is checking. This is not a costume you put on. It is the lens your soul chose for this life, and it is the first gift you hand a room. Lean into it. The world does not need another copy of what already exists. It needs your angle.

Put those three together and the spine of you is already clear. A truth-seeker at the core, steadied by deep, patient, grounded roots underneath, who meets the world by reframing it and leading with originality. You are built to chase big meaning, but not recklessly, because the ground under you is solid, and you hand people a new way of seeing as you go. Hold that shape in your mind. Everything else in your chart hangs off this spine.

## How you operate: Mercury, Venus, Mars

---

Your Big Three are the core of you. These next three are the daily machinery, how you actually think, love, and act.

♿ **Your Mercury in Capricorn.** Mercury is how your mind works: how you process, learn, and communicate. Yours is in Capricorn, the architect, so your mind builds in order. Here is what that looks like. You are the one who turns a mess into a plan. When everyone else is reacting, you are quietly sequencing the steps, working out what comes first, second, third. You often will not say a thing until the thought is fully formed, which can read as quiet, but inside you are constructing. You give people practical advice, not feel-good fluff, because your mind only trusts what actually works. When you learn something new, you want the real structure of it, the order, not scattered pieces. And notice where this mind of yours wants to aim itself: not just at your own private plans, but outward, at groups and community, at organizing something for a circle bigger than you. You think at your sharpest when you are building structure for a community, a team, an audience, or a cause. Use this on purpose. When life feels like too much, your way out is always the same: break it into a sequence and take the first concrete step.

♀ **Your Venus in Capricorn.** Venus is how you love and what you value, in romance and in every relationship. Yours is also in Capricorn, so you love the way you think, seriously and for keeps. Here is what that looks like. You do not show love with big flashy gestures. You show it by showing up, by being reliable, by handling what needs handling and building something solid. You are slow to fully commit, but once you do, you are in for the long haul and you mean it. You are drawn to substance over flash, to people and things with real weight that will still be standing in ten years. This matters for how you see yourself and others: do not measure love, yours or anyone else's, by the size of the gesture. Yours speaks in consistency. And it shows up most in your friendships and the community you build around you, your circle, your people, the group you choose and keep. You commit to them the way you commit to everything, slowly and for keeps, and belonging to something real with people who last means more to you than you usually let on. Notice the people who show up the same quiet way, and do not overlook them because they are not loud about it.

♂ **Your Mars in Pisces.** Mars is your drive, your engine, how you go after what you want. Yours is in Pisces, and this is the most interesting tension in your chart. Your mind is a Capricorn architect, all structure and order, but your drive is Pisces water, all feeling and

intuition. Here is what that looks like. You do not charge straight at a goal the way a harder Mars would. You move toward what you want sideways, when it feels right, carried by inspiration more than by force. On the days the feeling is there, you are unstoppable. On the days it is not, grinding through on willpower alone does not work for you the way it seems to work for everyone else, and that has probably frustrated you. It is not a flaw, it is a design. Stop trying to force yourself forward like a machine. Your fuel is inspiration and meaning, so the move is to tie whatever you have to do to something that actually matters to you, and your drive comes online on its own. And because this drive sits right at the surface of who you are, people feel it in your presence before you say a word. The intuitive, feeling-led way you move is not buried somewhere deep. It is the first thing you lead with, woven right into how you carry yourself and how you start things.

So you think like an architect and you love like one, steady and built to last, but you are driven by feeling. Honor both. Build the structure, and trust the current that actually moves you through it.

## Your growth path: Jupiter, Saturn, North Node

---

These run deeper than personality, into where you expand, where you struggle, and where your soul is trying to go.

♃ **Your Jupiter in Virgo.** Jupiter is where life opens up for you with the least resistance. Think of it as your cheat code. Yours is in Virgo, the sign of service and craft, so your luck turns on in close, one-on-one relationships, whenever you are of genuine, detailed service to one person right in front of you. Here is what that looks like. When you stop trying to help everyone at once and instead pour real care into one person, one problem, one piece of work done properly, doors open. The more carefully you serve, the more comes back, often from directions you did not expect. So when you step into a new season and you want things to grow, do not chase the spotlight. Find the one person you can genuinely help, sit down with them directly, and help them well. That is your engine for luck, and you can pull that lever any time.

♄ **Your Saturn in Cancer.** Saturn is your teacher, and it teaches the hard way, usually early. Yours is in Cancer, the sign of feeling and emotional safety, so the place you had to struggle was around letting yourself be seen and emotionally open. And it shows up most

sharply wherever you have to put something of yourself out there to be witnessed: creating, expressing yourself, your joy, stepping into any kind of spotlight. Here is what that looks like. Being vulnerable, showing what you feel, letting people all the way in, that did not come free for you the way it does for some. You likely learned to keep it guarded, to handle things on your own, to stay composed when you were anything but. Here is the gift hidden in that. Saturn does not punish, it builds. The very thing that was hard, being emotionally real and letting yourself be seen, becomes a strength you own for life, held with a steadiness most people never develop. Stop reading the early struggle as a wound. It was the training.

♋ **Your North Node in Taurus.** Your North Node is the direction your soul is reaching this lifetime. It is not where you are comfortable. It is where you grow. Yours is in Taurus, and to understand it you have to see where you came from. Your South Node, the place you arrived already overloaded with, is Scorpio: intensity, crisis, depth, running on adrenaline and other people's storms. And you tend to reach for it in a particular way, by chasing the big far-off answer, the grand truth waiting somewhere out on the horizon, the meaning that lives off in the distance. It is familiar, so you default to it under pressure, but it does not grow you anymore. Taurus is the opposite, and it is the assignment. Steady. Simple. Grounded. Building one real, lasting thing with patience and peace, with your own two hands. Here is what that looks like day to day, and it is closer to home than you would expect. The growth is not out chasing the grand far-off truth, it is in the small and the near: your daily routines, your own plain words, the simple steady practice of saying what is true and building one real thing a day. Calm over chaos. The slow steady build over the dramatic leap. The simple real thing over the intense complicated one. The move is from the mountaintop to the kitchen table. Every time you choose the close and the grounded over the storm, you are walking toward what your soul actually came here for.

## Where your life concentrates

---

Step back from the individual pieces and a pattern shows up. Charts are rarely even. Most people have one or two areas of life where their energy quietly piles up, and yours is unusually clear about where.

The center of gravity in your whole chart is your work and your place in the world. More of you points there than anywhere else, which is why a public calling is not optional for you, it is the assignment. Several of the heaviest pieces of who you are pull in that direction, your core self and your deepest drive among them. You are built to put something out in the open, work that means something and that other people can actually see. A life lived entirely in private would never sit right with you. You are here to build something the world can witness.

Close behind it is people. Your community, the circle and the group you gather around you. Your thinking and your values both lean that way, so your mind and your heart are aimed outward, at a community you are meant to serve or build, not only at your own small circle.

And the way you come at all of it, the very first thing anyone feels from you, is intuitive and original. It is not tucked away. It is the doorway to everything else, the first thing people get from you.

And underneath all of it runs a quiet spiritual current, a behind-the-scenes part of your chart that keeps you connected to something larger, felt more than explained. It is a big part of why meaning matters to you the way it does.

## The thread that ties it together

---

Now step back from the pieces and look at the whole, because a chart is not a list of traits. It is one story.

Here is yours. You are here to seek and share meaning out in the world, in the open, in your own original voice. The whole weight of your chart pushes that calling into your work and your public life. Your mind and your heart both lean toward people, so it is meant to reach a community, not stay private. You lead with originality and intuition, and a quiet current underneath keeps you reaching for what is real.

There is one tension to make peace with, and it is the engine of your growth. Your mind is built to plan and build in careful order, but your drive runs on feeling. You are most yourself when you stop making those two fight and let them work together: build the structure, then trust the current that moves you through it.

And the way your soul is meant to grow into all of it is not through more intensity or bigger leaps. It is through steadiness. Through showing up, day after day, building one real thing with patience and saying it plainly. That steady daily practice is not the small life for you. It is the whole point. It is where everything else you are finally lands.

## Where to go from here

---

You now have the bones of your chart. Read this more than once. Take one piece at a time and ask yourself three honest questions: where do I see this in my actual life, is it working for me or running me from the dark, and what would using it on purpose look like. That is how a reading becomes real change instead of words on a page.

And hold onto this. Your chart is not your fate. It is your design. It does not tell you what is going to happen. It shows you how you are built, so you can work with yourself instead of against yourself. You still walk the road. This just hands you the map.

Here is the honest truth about a reading like this one, though. It is a snapshot. It shows you who you are. But your chart is alive. The sky keeps moving against it, and every season of your life brings a different pressure, a different opening, a different lesson. Knowing your design is the beginning. Living it well, in real time, as life actually unfolds, is the work of years.

That is why I take on a small number of people as their personal astrologer. Not a one-time reading you walk away from. An ongoing relationship, the way you would keep a personal trainer for your body, except this is for your life and your timing. Each month I read what the sky is doing against your chart and tell you exactly how to work with it. When a real decision or a hard season hits, you have me to bring it to. And the whole way through, I am steering you toward what your chart says you are actually here to become.

It is selective, and it is built for people who are serious about living in alignment with their design, not just curious about it. If that is you, reach out and tell me you want to talk about working together. We will start there.

And if a single deep session is more what you need right now, I offer that too. But if you want someone in your corner for the long walk, the personal astrologer relationship is where the real change happens.

Your chart already knows who you are. The only question left is whether you are going to live it on purpose.
